Create an enduring legacy. Endowment funds provide a perpetual stream of income to support UAMA's priorities and serve to help fulfill its mission for future generations to have access to our collections. Donors may name a physical space in the museum; establish named curatorial positions, exhibitions or internships; or support new acquisitions and general operations.

Donor Advised Funds and Foundations

Supporting UAMA through donor-advised funds or private foundations can ensure your impact on increased access to the visual arts and arts education. To determine the tax treatment of proposed contributions and any other restrictions that apply to these grants, donors should consult their donor-advised fund ("DAF") manager, tax advisors and/or legal counsel.
